Audition Packet

Auditions – accepted until September 14th

This packet contains all the information that you need to prepare for your audition. Make sure to read it over carefully. If you have questions please call Marianne at 442-4270.

Please fill out the conflict sheet (on last page of packet) and include it, along with a recent 8x10 color headshot, resume along with a link to your song cut and one minute or less monologue.

Everyone will audition with a memorized monologue (less than 1 minute) and a song from the selected *James and the Giant Peach* cuts which are posted on the BAND app.

First rehearsal will begin Monday, October 5th. The cast list will be posted by Thursday October 24th. Scripts and vocal tracks will be sent at that time and cast members should come to rehearsal on the 5th partially memorized.

Audition Info

Prior to the Audition

Rehearse your introduction, monologue and song in front of family and friends as much as possible. Remember this should be fun!

Filming your audition

Make sure you shoot it in landscape (horizontal) position. Have a plain background and good lighting and sound.

Do I have to have an appointment to audition?

No, you just have to submit an audition by September 19th at 5:00 p.m.

If I audition am I guaranteed a role in the show?

No. We will only cast 9 in each cast, for a total of 18 actors.

Can my parents watch callbacks?

No. Due to Covid-19 restrictions we cannot have anyone else at the callbacks.

Do I have to be a current member of Grandstreet Theatre School to audition?

Yes, you must be signed up for at least the first two sessions to audition.

How old do you have to be to audition?

James and the Giant Peach has roles for 8 actors who look high school age and one actor who looks 10 years old

Will Grandstreet Theatre double cast this show? Yes.

Will I get comp tickets to this show?

No.

How do you communicate with parents?

We will ask you to download the BAND app. All communication will be through there.

Where do I find a monologue that is age appropriate?

The best place to look is in plays or books that you (or your child) are reading. Make sure the books are written in first person and that the passage chosen is not too passive. There are also monologue books available with children's monologues in the library. Some are good and some are mediocre. Please do not use poetry.

Do we need a song for these auditions?

Yes, we will use songs from *James and The Giant Peach*The audition cuttings are available on soundcloud Please use only these cuttings

Will it cost me anything to participate?

Each student is asked to sell 5 raffle tickets for our scholarship fund. Raffle tickets sell for \$20.00 a piece or 3 for \$50.00.

You may be asked to purchase a pair of socks, or find black shoes but the cost will be minimal and should not keep anyone from auditioning. If necessary we can help out with these costs. However, you must be current with your tuition payments for classes.

Do I still attend class if I am in the production?

Yes! We work on different projects in class so we need your attendance in class as well.

Can I sing for a certain role?

Yes. Please go to the <u>website</u> and look at the character breakdown. Choose one that you think you are the right type to play (it may not be the one that is your favorite).

How to fill out the Conflict Sheet

Please list ALL conflicts that you have from September 23rd-December 3rd between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. This means don't list things that happen before 6:00 p.m. (Don't forget chorus/band/orchestra concerts, girl scouts, dance lessons, birthday parties, vacations, state student council convention, etc) We will excuse you from any rehearsal listed on this sheet. If it is not on this sheet you WILL NOT be excused from rehearsal. Any unexcused absence will mean dismissal from the production.
