When & Where is the audition?

If I audition am I guaranteed a role in the show?

Yes, if we have all the materials. Conflict sheet, headshot, resume and audition you will have a role in the cast or crew

Do I have to be a current member of Grandstreet Theatre School to audition?

Yes, you must be signed up for at least Session 1 to audition.

How old do you have to be to audition?

you must be in school (K-12).

Will Grandstreet Theatre double cast this show?

We will double cast 3rd grade and under, possibly the ensemble. Lead/supporting roles will have understudies, most likely.

Will I get comp tickets to this show?

No.

Will we rehearse/perform in masks?

We might rehearse in masks. At this point we will not perform in masks but masks will be required offstage. All of this is subject to change depending on the COVID situation

How do you communicate with parents?

We will ask you to download the BAND app. All communication will be through there.

Where do I find a monologue that is age appropriate?

The best place to look is in plays or books that you (or your child) are reading. Make sure the books are written in first person and that the passage chosen is not too passive. There are also monologue books available with children's monologues in the library. Some are good and some are mediocre. Please do not use poetry.

Do we need a song for these auditions?

Yes, we will use songs from *Rudolph the Red-Nosed Jr.* The audition cuttings are available [on soundcloud or in the audition folder posted on BAND.](#) Please use only these cuttings

Will it cost me anything to participate?

Each student is asked to sell 5 raffle tickets for our scholarship fund. Raffle tickets sell for \$20.00 a piece or 3 for \$50.00. There is a cash prize for the top three sellers.

You may be asked to purchase a pair of socks, or find black shoes but the cost will be minimal and should not keep anyone from auditioning. If necessary we can help out with these costs. However, you must be current with your tuition payments for classes.

Do I still attend class if I am in the production?

Yes! We work on different projects in class so we need your attendance in class as well.

Can I sing for a certain role?

Please go to the and look at the [character breakdown.](#) Choose one that you think you are the right type to play (it may not be the one that is your favorite). If you want to be in the ensemble, please choose one of the songs for ensemble.

How to fill out the Conflict Sheet

Please list ALL conflicts that you have from September 26th-December 1st between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. This means don't list things that happen before 6:00 p.m. (Don't forget chorus/band/orchestra concerts, girl scouts, dance lessons, birthday parties, vacations, state student council convention, etc) We will excuse you from any rehearsal listed on this sheet. If it is not on this

sheet you WILL NOT be excused from rehearsal. Any unexcused absence will mean dismissal from the production. There will be no conflicts allowed for your assigned tech/dress rehearsals and performances:
